About The Deposit Protection Corporation

The Deposit Protection Corporation is an independent statutory body operating in terms of the Deposit Protection Corporation Act (Chapter 24:29) to administer the Deposit Protection Scheme in Zimbabwe. Its main objectives include protecting depositors by providing an orderly means of compensation in the event of a bank failure and contributing towards the stability and public confidence in the country's financial system.

Key Job Functions:

- Evaluate, analyze, measure and monitor each banking institution's risk exposure to the Deposit Protection Fund.
- Conduct premium assessments payable by each contributory institution.
- Conduct on-going reviews of contributory institutions' compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
- Liaise with contributory institutions on any matter concerning deposit protection.
- Maintain and update DPC's statistical database to ensure data integrity.
- Develop and constantly review risk analysis policies and manuals in line with international best practices.
- Initiate and recommend policy and legislation reviews.
- Produce management and stakeholder information reports.

The ideal incumbent will have a minimum of the following:

- A degree in Banking, Accounting, Economics, Statistics, Risk Management, Business Studies or acceptable equivalent.
- Possession of a postgraduate qualification is a must.
- At least 5 years relevant experience.
- Experience obtained from a banking environment, forensic auditing or prudential regulation.
- Wide knowledge and extensive demonstrable competences in risk management, financial modeling, stress testing and computerized financial reporting is highly desirable.
- Have a sound understanding of the Banking Act, Deposit Protection Act and related regulatory statutes.
- Ability to research and interpret local, regional and global economic trends.
- Must have advanced skills in Microsoft Office tools such as Excel, Word and PowerPoint.
